

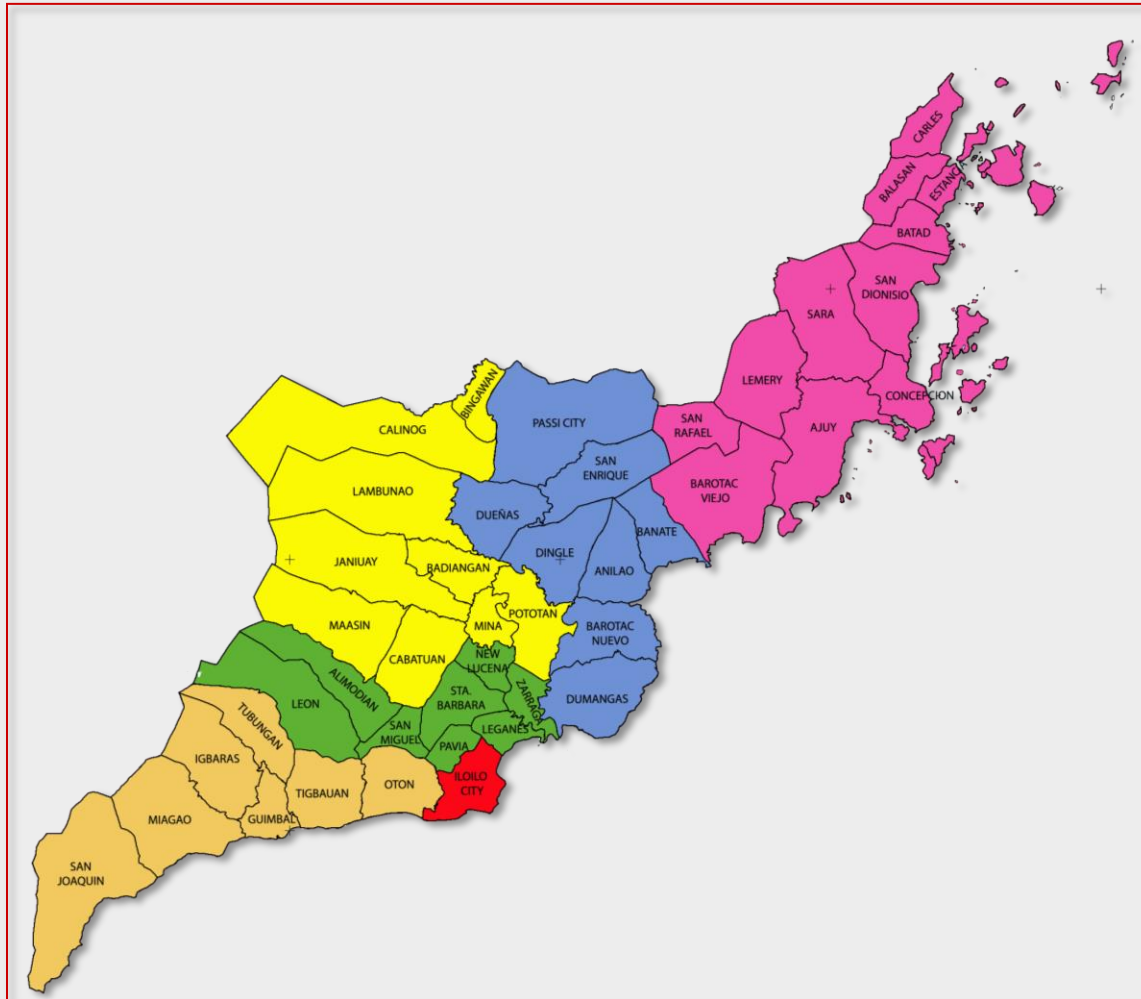

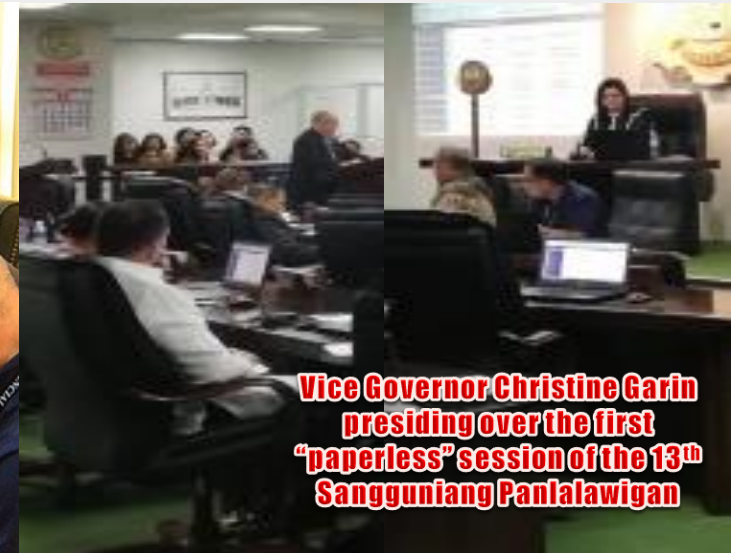

On Healthcare Systems Capacity

Problems affecting hospital system:

- Capacities of the provincial and district hospitals in health service remains a challenge
- Need to expand infrastructure and upgrade services
- Lack of upgraded IT infrastructure for digital records management

Why is it important?

- Affects ability of IPG hospital system to comply with the requirements of Universal Healthcare Law

Problems and Significance*

- Inadequate technology transfer mechanisms
- Expensive and inappropriate farm equipment for small farmers
- Marketing of commodities

On Sustainability of Fisheries

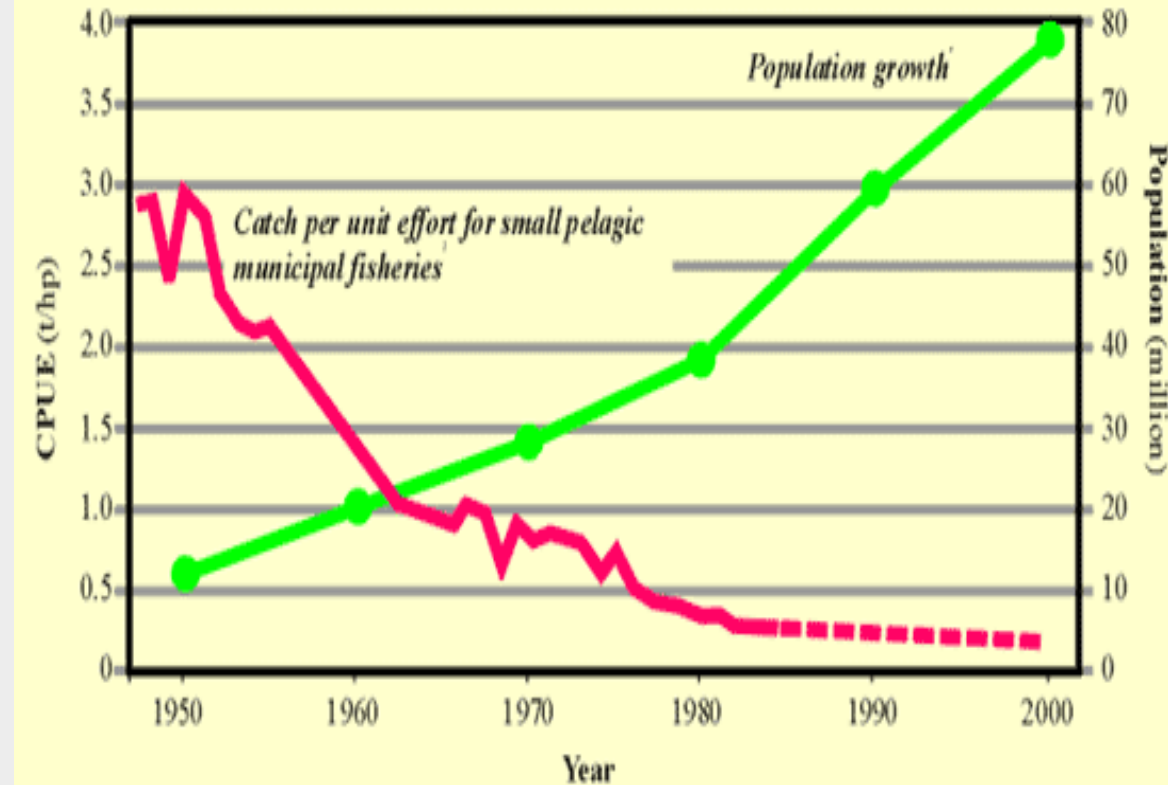
Problem and Significance*

Tourism Recovery

Problem and Significance*

- 99% decline in tourism demand
 - Slow reopening of tourism establishments
- * Recovery is important as tourism interface with other sectors, foremost, are agriculture and service sectors

Target Beneficiaries:

Sustained Health Watch and Emergency Response

Enhance compliance monitoring of COVID-19 health protocols and contact tracing using RIsCTrAP

Maintain health surveillance of other infectious diseases

Strengthen emergency preparedness and response thru the establishment of the Provincial Civil Defense Center

Economic Recovery

Revive establishments, industries and livelihood sectors affected by the implementation of community quarantine measures

Restore income in businesses

Provide employment opportunities

COVID-19 Health Response

1. Provision of infections control barriers in the triage and high traffic areas of the hospitals
2. Purchase of diagnostic and ancillary laboratory equipment for management of patients
3. Purchase of additional one (1) unit waste decomposer



COVID-19 Health Response

4. Capacity development/ Learning and Development of key hospital personnel on:

- a. Molecular Biology Technology for MedTechs
- b. Triage, infection control and prevention for nurses and nursing aides

5. Procurement and stockpiling of appropriate drugs and medicines, medical supplies, PPEs dedicated to ensure immediate availability of supplies in outbreaks and pandemics





ECONOMIC RECOVERY



1. Boost agriculture and fishery to restore lost capital and income due to unsold products, price differential and disrupted supply lines



1. Ensuring the availability and accessibility of agri-fishery products, through intensified and refocused programs, and by shifting to technology based methods
2. Promoting on-line marketing of agri-fishery products
3. Intensifying support services in the form of farm machinery and equipment

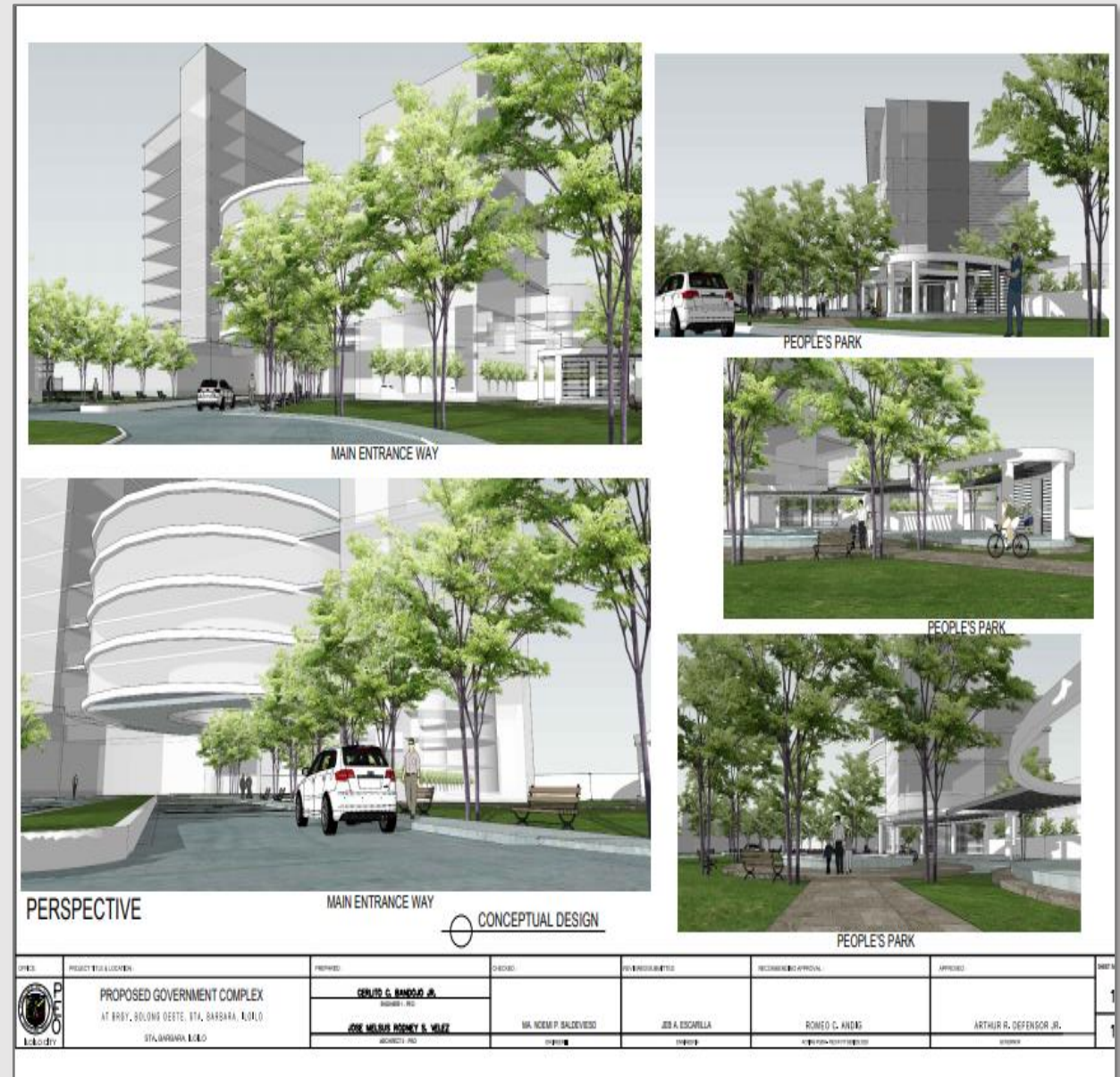
Project Components

- Power, water facilities, sewerage treatment and solid waste management

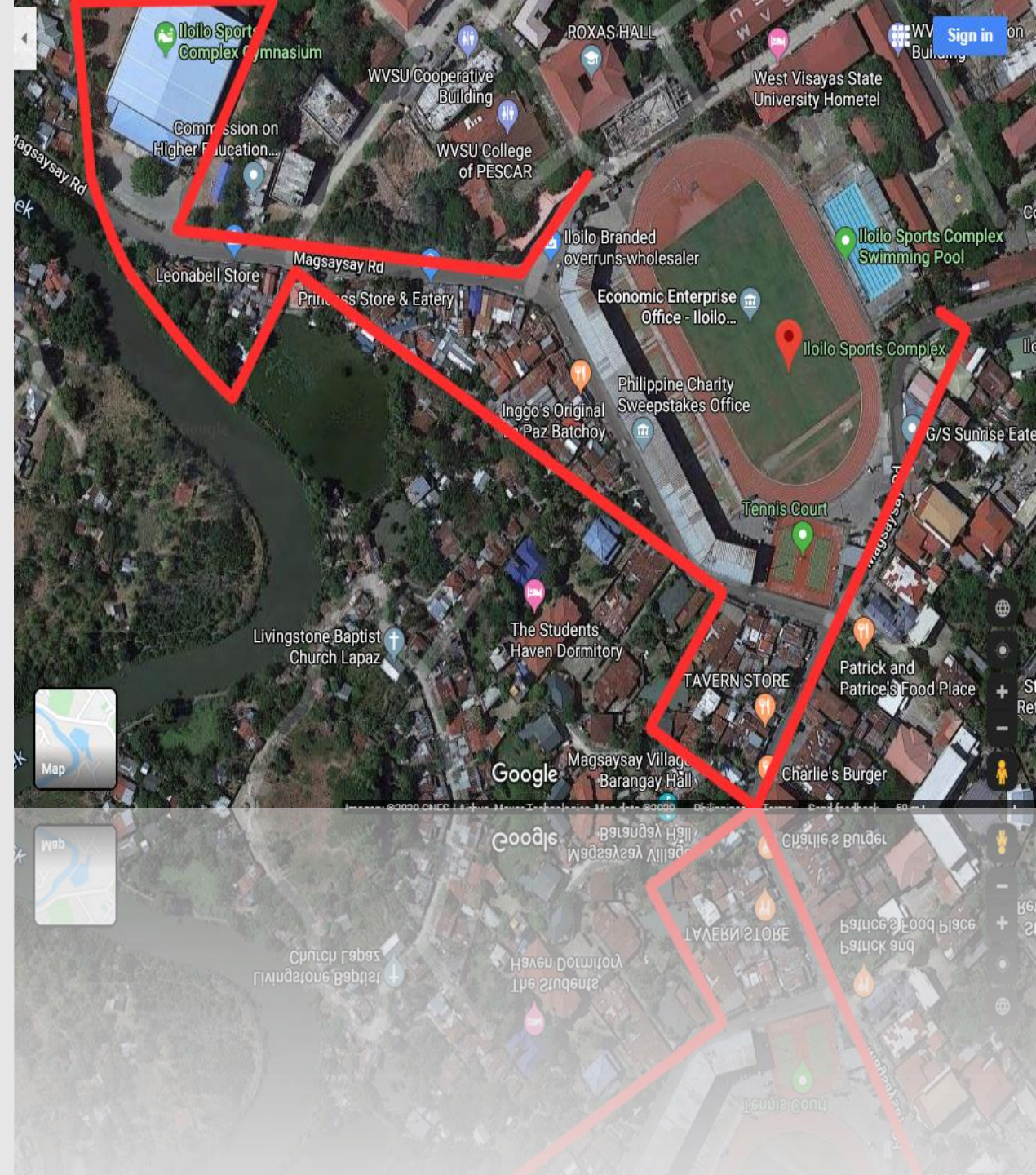


Iloilo Sports, Recreation and Wellness Hub Project

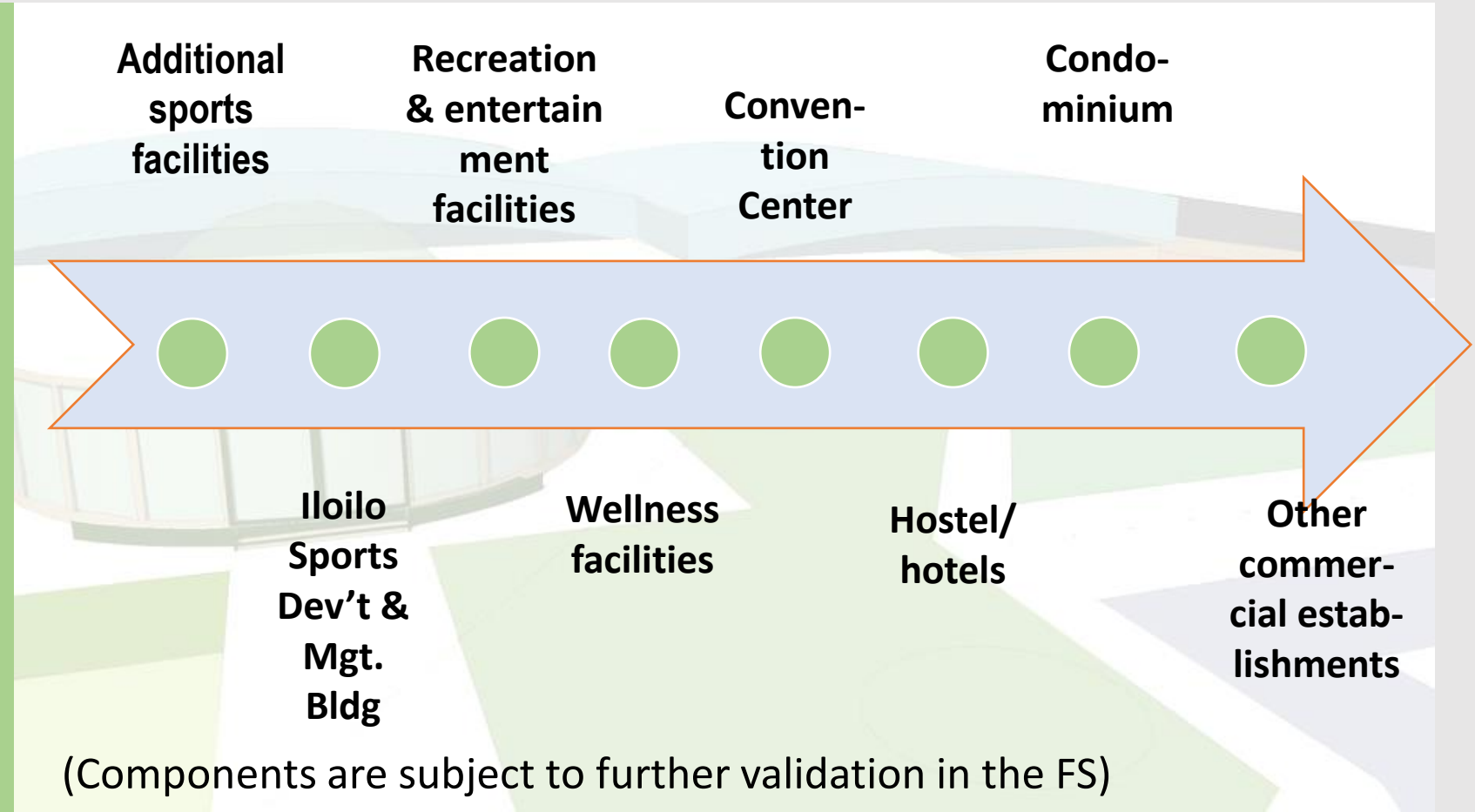

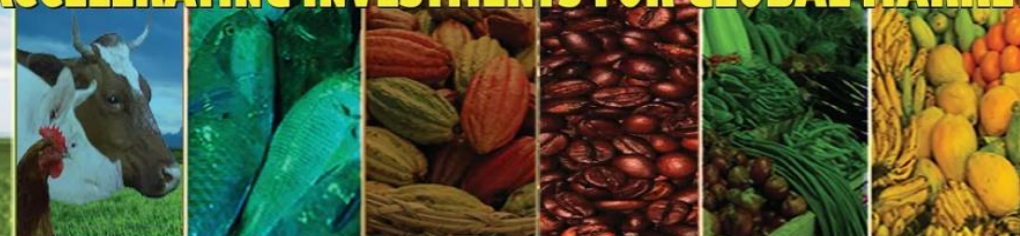
